

## Mexican-American War

- Mexico never recognized <u>Texas</u>
   being <u>annexed</u> to the US
- Mexico insists the border between Texas and the US is the <u>Nueces</u> river
- The <u>US</u> says its the <u>Rio Grande</u> River
- June 1845, <u>President Polk</u> ordered General Zachary Taylor to take troops into the disputed area




- Polk sends <u>John Slidell</u> into Mexico to settle the border dispute
  - O Mexico <u>refuses</u> to speak to him
- General Taylor camps at the Rio Grande
  - After refusing to withdraw
     Mexico and US troops clash
  - O Several US soldiers are killed



- "Mexico has passed the boundary of the US, has invaded our territory, and shed American blood upon the American soil...the two nations are now at war." - James Polk
- After 2 years of fighting
  - Zachary Taylor is replaced by Winfield Scott
  - Mexico City falls and Santa Anna flees





- February 1848, <u>Treaty of</u> <u>Guadalupe Hidalgo</u> ended the Mexican American War
  - Mexico had to return its northern territory to the US
    - This is called Mexican

      Cession: present day Utah,

      Nevada, California, and

      Arizona
      - US pays 15 million
    - Real border with Texas (Rio Grande)



## Bonus Land

- Gadsden Purchase
  - Americans wanted to make sure <u>railroads</u> to California in the south would solely be on American soil
  - James Gadsden negotiates with Mexico
    - For 10 million, the US
      purchases the southern
      parts of Arizona and New
      Mexico
